City Pathologists Meet, Chennai

The Science of Pathology has seen tremendous advances in the last few years. From the use of genomes

developments have been extensive with far-reaching consequences. Not only do these enable us deliver

better services to our patients, they also necessitate a change in the way we learn and indeed teach

The extent of progress also meant that no single Institution could understand and benefit from the enormity

of the changes in our field. Almost by the nature of the setup and facilities we operate under - the

Government and private teaching Institutions, Medical hospitals, Laboratories - each of us have our

distinguishing strengths / weaknesses to understand only a limited set of the above advancements.

However, collectively we can possibly look forward to a comprehensive understanding by sharing our

unique experiences and learnings.

The City Pathologists Meet was thus started as an initiative to foster a culture of learning and innovation

amongst fellow Pathologists in Chennai. This began with a small group of Pathologists when we had our

first meeting in MMC about 3 years back. Ever since, we have bee conducting meeting every alternate

month between 2:30 to 4 pm, on a Saturday. Our meetings are well attended with a gathering of around 40

Pathologists and typically around 8 to 10 interesting cases are posted and discussed in every meet. We

also encourage the PG students to present so as to provide adequate exposure to the budding Pathologists

as well.

In the last 3 years, the group has grown manifold and has participants from almost all of the leading medical

colleges and hospitals in Chennai. We have organized some special events as well. For example, MIOT

organized a one-day CME with demonstrations and presentations. In the 3 years since we started this, we
